As well as social commentary, particularly on gender issues, Ilsa has published sixteen books that range from memoir and light fiction to more serious subject matter such as euthanasia and family break-ups. Her last book (released in March 2023) is *Family Baggage*. Two earlier novels, *Broken* and *Sticks & Stones*, tell the story of an abused woman and are largely based on the findings of a PhD on the long-term effects of domestic violence. There's also 'The Nell Forrest Murders' series, set in the fictional county town of Majic and detailing the exploits of a rather reluctant, and slightly inept, sleuth.
